SHAVUOT AT THE MOUNTAIN — THE HEART OF THIS JOURNEY

Most expeditions come to Mount Sinai to see the place. This one comes to relish the day and keep it Holy. Shavuot, the Feast of Weeks, marks the day Yisrael stood before this mountain and heard the Voice of Elohim in the fire and the smoke. It was here, on the anniversary of that day, that the covenant was given and a people became a kingdom of priests. To arrive at the Mountain on the very date of that appointment, and to share the feast at its base as the sun goes down and the fiftieth day opens, is not a mere reenactment; rather, it is keeping the appointment He set. As Scripture records, "on that same day they came into the wilderness of Sinai" (Exodus 19:1). We will be there on the same day.

Further, the trip proceeds to the off-limits and protected sites where Moses and Joshua shared in the unfolding of His glory and miracles. You will learn on this visit the importance and the documentation to which they responded and in which they believed. The evidence has always been there, yet, Arabia has remained off-limits to Bible scholars who were prevented from being

able to see the land of Jethro, Mount Sinai, the land of the Exodus—including the Red Sea crossing—the area of Rephidim where the Yisraelites battled the Amalekites, the place of the Split Rock of Horeb where He provided water and then the Wilderness of Sinai and Mount Sinai where He formalized His covenant and provided the Ten Commandments to Moses. You will be witness to and see the earliest Hebrew languages directly in front of Mount Sinai in a cave that's hidden from view.

"And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

Deuteronomy 6:6

With that, and more, it was the great Exodus! You will then follow the route of the Hebrews to where 38 of their 40 years were spent wandering in the desert—near and surrounding the important Biblical places of Petra, then up to Shittim, the last place where Yahweh had laid out his camp plan for the Hebrews outside of the Land of Yisrael and to precious Bethany Beyond the Jordan, where Jesus Himself was baptized, and where Joshua led the Yisraelites across the Jordan River, plus so much more.

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EMBARK ON AN ANCIENT JOURNEY

The foundational narrative of the Exodus, as outlined in the second book of the Torah of Yahweh, contains some of the most vital and momentous accounts in the Torah. The quest to uncover the archaeological and geological evidence of the Yisraelites' liberation from Egypt, Moses' revelation at Mount Sinai, and the nation of Yisrael's ensuing desert wanderings has captured the hearts and minds of some of history's most brilliant scholars and explorers. Cartographers, archaeologists, scientists, adventurers, historians, and disciples of all backgrounds have sought out the genuine locations depicted in ancient manuscripts. Finally, with the advent of state-of-the-art technology and the ever-increasing political stability of the region, the northwest corner of Arabia has begun to divulge its buried secrets. This tour has been designed to include time at the end for further investigations, in which you may partake! You will be a first-hand witness to the expansion and revealing of the region's antiquities, which have remained behind the veil until this time.

Join author Todd D. 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ITINERARY AT-A-GLANCE



May 9: Guests using the suggested group air schedule out of Washington, Dulles, at 1:50PM, will change in Istanbul.

May 10: Flights arrive at Aqaba (first choice for ease) at 5:50PM on Turkish Air. Arrive at Amman or Tabuk, traveling to Haql on the Saudi/Jordanian border. Transfers are provided when using the suggested flight schedule. Guests overnight at the Haql Vista Hotel.

May 11: Rephidim, Split Rock, Snake Rock, overnight Red Sea, Vista hotel.

May 12: Mount Sinai, cemetery of the 3,000 from Exodus 32:28, Altar to the Golden Calf, stoves and molds of the Tabernacle, the Wilderness of Sinai, optional camping.

May 13: Visit the Altar of Moses on Mount Sinai, Shavuot meal, and celebration. Optional camping or return to Red Sea hotel. Todd Bennett will be at the campsite both nights, May 12 and 13.

May 14: Midian, Jethro's Tomb, Moses Well, Nuweiba Beach crossing site, Red Sea. Shabbat. Overnight, Red Sea Hotel.

May 15: Shabbat, day of rest. For those not practicing Shabbat, visit Mount Sinai for the Exodus 19:23 inscriptions and other inscriptions, the winepress, and the Moses altar sites.

May 16: Climbers climb, non-climbers sleep late, visit the Arabah and arrive in Aqaba, in Jordan, at lunch time. The group meets at 6:30PM for dinner in Aqaba.

May 17: Wadi Rum, four-wheel-drive adventure to the base of Mount Paran, sites of the Exodus encampments, and overnight under the stars at Suraya Luxury Camp.

May 18: Kings' Highway to Petra, Little Petra, Nabatean water cisterns, Beidha, Dead Sea, Jordan.

May 19: Heshbon (of King Sihon), Tel al Hammam, Shittim, Bethany Beyond the Jordan, Jordan river baptisms, time-permitting. Your Hilton hotel will allow you to return in the late afternoon as well to freshen up.

May 20: Depart Amman, Jordan, to Washington, Dulles, depart Amman at 1:30AM, arrive in Istanbul at 4:00AM on Turkish Air #413, then depart Istanbul at 7:40AM, arrive in Washington, Dulles, at 11:35AM on Turkish Air #187.

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ITINERARY-IN-DETAIL

May 9: Most guests will depart their home airports today. The group air program departs Washington, Dulles, airport at 1:50PM, with a layover in Istanbul for 6 hours in their lovely new airport with areas to sleep, shower, and rest. Guests will then continue on to Aqaba in Jordan on Turkish Airlines.

[Incl. Meals: B=Breakfast / L=Lunch / D=Dinner]

May 10: The group air program arrives in Aqaba at 5:50PM on Turkish Airlines. You will be met at the airport, and transferred to the Saudi Arabia border (20 minutes), you will be transferred through customs and arrive at the Haql Vista Hotel for dinner and overnight. If you choose to arrive in Amman, it is best to arrive no later than 12:00 noon or even better to arrive a night early. This also applies if you choose to begin the tour by flying into Tabuk. Living Passages can assist you in making those decisions. [D]



May 11: You will depart the Red Sea hotel and arrive at the site of Rephidim, where the Battle of the Amalekites took place, via your 4WD Land Cruisers. You will visit the battle areas and may scour the area for hand-hewn weapons, if you're so inclined. You'll see inscriptions pertaining to both the Hebrews and the Amalekites, as well as the viewpoints of a tremendous area of history. Next, you will be driven a short distance to the Split Rock of Horeb, where you will enjoy a spectacular lunch under the cover of a large tent. If you wish, you may climb the Split Rock and enjoy the surroundings. You may also visit several rock mounds, one of which has received speculation that it is the Jehoveh-nissi of Exodus 17:15. As you contemplate all of these things, ponder how the Saudi authorities have forbidden archaeologists access to these sites for well over 100 years, and how the area itself has prevented its disclosure to the world. We also stop at a mysterious rock, which we have named Snake Rock due to its strange, snake-like inscriptions, along with numerous ancient Hebrew inscriptions. The location of the rock is on the path of what would have potentially drawn Hebrew scouts, as it is over a raised landmass, like a small mountain directly behind Rephidim. You will return to your Red Sea hotel—the Vista. [BLD]

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ITINERARY-IN-DETAIL

May 12: Today, you arrive at the Mountain of Elohim, Jabal al-Lawz, where your camp will be set up. You will have the option of camping here with the group for one or two nights, or returning one of the nights to your hotel on the Red Sea. The goal is that everyone will be where they hope to be for Shavuot. Todd Bennett will be at the optional campsite both tonight and the night of May 13.

You will visit the ground of the Camp of Yisrael, where the people encamped before the mountain. Nearby, you will see the cemetery of the 3,000 of Exodus 32:28, "And the sons of Levi did according to the word of Moses. And that day about three thousand men of the people fell." You will then also see the ancient nearby inscriptions that document those who were slain with swords at the Golden Calf Altar. You will see the stoves and molds needed for the Tabernacle, and you will be driven through the Wilderness of Sinai. You will also come upon the Altar of the Golden Calf beneath the blackened summit, set among the curious inscriptions of Apis bulls bearing Egyptian features. As the sun begins to set, the day turns toward the feast of Shavuot. Tonight, the camp is prepared for the entire group at the foot of the Mountain, where you will share an authentic feast as the sun goes down and the appointed day begins. Should you prefer the comfort of a hotel bed, transportation back to the Vista will be provided this evening, but there will be a supplement charged to return to the hotel, single or double, at \$375 per person (per night). Todd Bennett will be at the campsite both nights, May 12 and 13. **[BLD]**



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ITINERARY-IN-DETAIL

May 13: Today is Shavuot, often referred to as Pentecost, which means "Fiftieth." The fiftieth day has already begun as the sun went down on the Feast the evening before, the count came to its end, and the special Appointed Time began. Today is the daytime portion of the High Sabbath of Shavuot. You will experience the Feast in the very place Yisrael first kept it after leaving Egypt. This is the day when the 10 Commandments were spoken from the Mountain. The Feast commemorates that event, and that is why it is a High Sabbath. While followers of the Messiah recognize that the Spirit was sent on this same Day in Jerusalem, they often miss the connection with Sinai. So, there is a lot to consider on this amazing day at this incredible location as we observe a day set apart from ordinary work and given to rest. Having remained through the night at the foot of the Mountain, you will spend it together as a camp, resting and fellowshiping beneath the blackened summit. This is a truly authentic experience where you can connect with what the Scriptures describe as the ancient path. There is nowhere you need to be and no schedule to keep. As the shadows lengthen across the wilderness, you will gather for teaching on the covenant that was given here, on the very day it was given, and have time to sit, to talk with one another, explore the actual campsite of the Yisraelites, and to remember the Voice that once thundered from this mountain.

It is also possible to walk to Moses' altar to Yahweh (30 minutes), via the cleansing riverbed, and see marble pillars for the Twelve Tribes of Yisrael. Those wishing to return to the Vista Hotel to sleep will be able to do so, and transportation will be provided, single or double, at \$375 per person (per night). For those wishing to spend Shabbat at the Red Sea Hotel (Vista), departure from the camp will be at 4:00PM, in order to be at the hotel by sunset. For those wishing to camp, tonight will be very special. **[BLD]**



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ITINERARY-IN-DETAIL



May 14: Today, you will be driven to the ancient oasis of Al Bid—the Land of Midian, first visiting the Museum of Archaeology. At Al-Bid (in Midian), you will walk through the caves of Jethro—Moses' father-in-law—and visit the well site of Moses and Zipporah. You will have a lovely lunch at an Arabian horse ranch nearby and then stop at the Red Sea crossing site directly in front of Nuweiba Beach, Egypt. After a time of worship and reflection, Shabbat begins this evening. You will stay at the Red Sea Hotel. **[BLD]**



May 15: Today is Shabbat; those celebrating a quiet day at the Vista Hotel Haql will have lunch at the hotel. Those not celebrating Shabbat will be revisiting the Archers of Exodus 19:23, "And Moses said to the Lord, 'The people cannot come up to Mount Sinai, for you yourself warned us, saying, 'Set limits around the mountain and consecrate it.'" You will also be visiting other inscription sites that are at the base of Mount Sinai. Your group returns to the Vista Hotel, Haql, at sunset, for dinner in Haql. **[BLD]**

May 16: Climbers will depart the hotel at 5:00AM. Those not climbing will visit the Arabah and sites of the Exodus crossing near the Saudi border, cross into Jordan, and check into the lovely Movenpick Resort Hotel. Your lunch today will be on your own in the quaint town of Aqaba, with its shopping, ice cream shops, and a beautiful beach. Climbers arrive at the hotel in Aqaba at dinner time. **[BD]**

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ITINERARY-IN-DETAIL

May 17: You will have breakfast at the resort and then have your last glimpse of the Red Sea. You will be driven into the world-famous Wadi Rum. The landscape at Wadi Rum was made famous as the site for many movies. More importantly, it is the overwhelmingly beautiful desert of the Exodus. You will be driven to a beautiful new camp called Saraya. Once there, you will climb back into your four-wheel drive vehicles and be driven to Biblical Mount Paran. Mount Paran marks one of the wilderness camps of the journey, near where the children of Yisrael moved after Miriam—the sister of Moses—was shut outside the camp for seven days, the account recorded in Numbers 12. You will enjoy tea and time in the desert to admire the camels and rock formations that will provide ample shade and your own, unique adventures. You will be returned to your beautiful camp for a fabulous meal, time in front of a roaring fire, and a blanket of stars. Your overnight will be spent at the Saraya luxury, tented camps (which include full bathrooms with running water in each fixed, tented structure). [BLD]

May 18: You will be driven via the Kings' Highway to Petra, walking through the basin. You will be a part of amazing discussions that will focus on the Hebrews who most likely spent 38 of their 40 years in and out of this remote and well-hidden place of refuge. Your tour will end at the Christian section of Petra, and you will see where tombs were carefully converted into churches, which included baptismal fonts. It's somewhat curious how the site began as a place for Esau, then became a place of refuge for the Hebrews, then a beautiful place of renewal after the death of Christ Jesus! You will end your visit today at a rarely-visited Neolithic site called Beidha. It is here that you will take part in a discussion of the time period of Esau and then the layout of the agriculture and food production that took place 3600 years before. You will end your day at the beautiful Hilton, Dead Sea in Jordan, where you will have dinner and overnight. [BLD]

May 19: Today, you may have a morning swim or take a dip in the fabulous mineral pools. Your first site today is Heshbon, which was important in the segment of the conquest, including Joshua 3:10, 13:17, and the home of King Sihon in Numbers 21:26. You will have lunch and then visit the oldest archaeological site in the modern-day country of Jordan, Tel al Hammam. At the base of Tel al Hammam is your target site—Shittim. The site of Shittim is the last place that the Tabernacle was set up in Yahweh's commanded formation outside of Yisrael. It is also the site where Baal of Peor could view the Hebrews below and the important tent. Finally, today, you will be on the Jordan River, so important as this is where Joshua would have brought the Hebrews across to the Promised Land, where Jesus Himself was baptized by John at Bethany Beyond the Jordan, and where Elijah was swept into heaven. Depending on how much time is spent with baptisms, you will be returned to the Hilton hotel to refresh. If you are on the group air departure back to the USA, you will be leaving the hotel at 10:00PM, or later, depending on your own schedule. [BL]

May 20: Depart Amman, Jordan, to Washington, Dulles, depart Amman at 1:30AM, arrive in Istanbul at 4:00AM on Turkish Air #413, then depart Istanbul at 7:40AM, arrive in Washington, Dulles, at 11:35AM on Turkish Air #187.

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ADVENTURE EXCURSION IN ARABIA WITH OPTIONAL OVERNIGHTS AT JABAL AL-LAWZ (MOUNT SINAI!)

Expenses for this excursion are tied to the cost of camp set-up, as opposed to the number of nights spent there by individuals. ***Note: to be able to spend Shavuot at Sinai, you must spend at least one night camping, but you may spend up to two nights camping.

Hiking & Climbing: You may climb to the blackened top, OR you may climb to Elijah's Cave (You cannot do both the blackened top and Elijah's Cave on the same day. Hike to the 70 Elders' Plateau. You will spend an overnight camping under the summit plateau of Jabal al-Lawz. The journey includes camping for two nights, but you have the option not to camp at all, or you may camp only one of the two nights.

If you are looking to take a more adventurous route into the wilderness, your Saudi Arabia Adventure package offers an alternative path designed for tour participants who can enjoy the amazing location of the camp and its facilities. This option highlights Moses' time in the land of Midian and the Exodus crossing sites, and includes exploration of the real Mount Sinai by hiking and camping along the same route that Moses may have taken. You will be partaking in classic fellowship and learning at the main sites throughout the tour, but with extra

activities added in, as desired! If you enjoy an activity level that is different from your spouse's or travel companion's, you have the option to select different activities. You may choose the adventure that is perfect for you!

While the trip includes two nights of camping at Mount Sinai, with all meals, a shower onsite, and a mobile, regular restroom facility, you can return to the Vista hotel for an overnight, either one of the nights or both nights. The additional cost is \$375 per person, per night, at the hotel.

We will also have a separate day for climbing Mount Sinai (May 16), and the most notable climbs can include the following:

- + Climb to Elijah's Cave (5-6 hours)
- + Climb and boulder to the 70 Elders' Plateau (5-7 hours)
- + Climb to the blackened peak of Jabal al-Lawz (6-9 hours)

IMPORTANT FOR ACCEPTANCE INTO THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA

In the past years, travel to the Kingdom was not allowed with Israeli stamps in your passport. That is no longer the case as of today. Be advised that you will be fingerprinted and undergo a retinal scan upon arrival in the country. The country is undergoing a remarkable restoration and we cannot predict if a site might be under construction. Be sure to study-up on the artificial intelligence operated area called NEOM. Our travels will take us into the middle area of it.

IMPORTANT TRAVEL DETAILS

The trip is not considered "active" unless it is something you want to participate in. Most of the sights in Saudi Arabia are within steps of your Land Cruiser, but if you do want to participate in an activity, there are opportunities on two of the Saudi expedition days. If you are not looking for activity, just know that walking is on fairly normal surfaces, and vehicles will be available to visit a few of the other nearby inscriptions and sites. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PROPER DOCUMENTATION

All members of this tour must carry passports that are valid for at least six months beyond their scheduled date of return (that is, until November 25, 2027). A visa will be required for Saudi Arabia; a link will be sent to you. It is very easy to complete the form. At the present time, the fee is \$85 USD. You can opt to have us arrange the visa for you, for an additional cost of \$125 per person. Visas for Jordan are included. No vaccinations are required. However, please note that things may also change. Please note that the vendors will have already accepted your booking, knowing that there is a current global threat. Therefore, if you book this tour, you are accepting the terms of the airlines, the TSA, the countries to which you are traveling, and/ or other governing parties without fully knowing what they will be by the time that you actually travel.

AIR TICKETS

You are welcome to book any air schedule you prefer. We do offer a recommended round-trip air schedule on Turkish Airlines from Washington, Dulles. Turkish Airlines also operates in about 11 other cities in North America and all over the world. They offer an economy class price, or you can receive a business class quote as well. If you wish to arrange your own air schedule and you would like us to include airport arrival and departure transfers, please arrive and depart so that you match our flights. There are alternative schedules to Amman in Jordan, and it would take a 4-hour transfer via car for you to meet us in Aqaba. You can also choose to fly into the city of Tabuk in Saudi Arabia, that also will take a 3.5 hour transfer from Tabuk to our hotel in Saudi Arabia, in the city of Haql. As a general estimate, a car transfer either from Amman or Tabuk would be approximately \$375 per vehicle. The schedule we recommend you use is as follows:

May 9: Depart Washington, Dulles to Aqaba, Jordan on Turkish Air #188 at 1:20PM, arrive Istanbul at 6:10AM, change planes, depart Istanbul at 3:10PM, and arrive in Aqaba at 5:50PM on Turkish Air #834/

May 20: Depart Amman, Jordan to Washington, Dulles, depart Amman at 1:30AM, arrive Istanbul at 4:00AM on Turkish Air #413, then depart Istanbul at 7:40AM, arrive Washington, Dulles, at 11:35AM on Turkish Air #187.

LIMITATIONS

The air carrier(s), group operators, and LP reserve the right to substitute equipment and properties and to add or delete en-route stops at our discretion, with or without notice. The hotels, airlines, ground operators, and other vendors used by LP reserve the right, in special circumstances, to substitute accommodations/transportation and sights of similar or better quality without penalty. This includes sites as noted on the itinerary. If taking the extension, understand that the KSA is in its infancy. Because of this, they can choose to do site work that may affect our visits.

SINGLES

We match roommates! If you are a single person or traveling alone, we do have others who would like to travel with us without paying the single supplement. We assign roommates, as available, approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. We cannot guarantee it, but it has worked well in the past for many of our travelers.

MAKING YOUR DEPOSIT / RESERVATIONS

- There is no deadline for making a booking; we will continue to take bookings as late as possible.
- If depositing prior to January 15, 2027, a deposit of \$1,250 per person is due along with your signed registration form. If booking after January 15, 2027, full payment is due within 5 days of your registration. Payments not received by the due date are subject to a 5% monthly finance charge and the possible cancellation of the reservation.
- Please note we will continue to take bookings and reservations until our departure, as long as space is available, and we will do everything possible to make sure you can join us!
- You may use a credit card for your initial deposit and optional insurance and then pay the balance with cash, check, or wire transfer and still receive the full cash discount.

CHANGES / REVISIONS

We will try to accommodate name changes, but additional fees may be imposed and passed on by the carriers. If specific rooming requests are altered due to cancellation by one or more passengers, the passenger(s) still traveling may be required to pay the resulting applicable occupancy rate. Trip insurance may cover this additional cost.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

Your deposit is not refundable. As we get close to departure, penalties increase. Please purchase insurance to protect your deposits. Insurance will cover you if your policy suits your circumstances. We also offer "Cancel-for-Any-Reason" insurance. The penalty will increase 96 days prior to your scheduled departure date.

- At 96 days prior to departure, the cancellation penalty increased to 45%, plus all air travel is nonrefundable.
- At 75 days prior, the trip becomes nonrefundable.

Credits transferred from another tour are subject to the non-recoverable costs in place at the time of transfer. These funds will remain non-refundable. Travel insurance premiums and airfare are always non-refundable. All tour credits need to be used within 2 years from your original outbound date with the vendor or destination.

LP is not responsible for government actions, weather, mechanical breakdowns, war, terrorism, acts of nature (secularly known as "Acts of God"), denying entrance to a site due to political or other reasons, or other circumstances beyond its control. If a travel ban is imposed by the United States on any country, we are scheduled to tour, and we will attempt to secure another destination. We cannot be held accountable due to political decisions. In the event of delay, the airline or tour company, and not LP, determines delay procedures and the amenities/compensation, if any, to be offered. LP will not accept responsibility for additional charges incurred for expenses or lost wages as a result of changes to flight times, and/or missed vacation time.

ACTIVITIES

Participants may choose to engage in various activities, including, but not limited to, climbing, camel-riding/participating in camel races, 4-wheeling, hiking, swimming, and other "activities." Participants are hereby notified that these and other activities may be dangerous and may result in serious injury and that participation in these activities shall be at the participant's own risk. Living Passages (herein referred to as LP) shall not be liable for any injuries sustained by cruise/tour participants, which are a result of participants engaging in such activities.

TRAVELERS WHO NEED SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

You will be notified quickly and prior to being billed for final payment if any vendors make any of these types of increases. You may arrange your own air travel.

CURRENCY AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Pricing of the tour and event was based on the currency that was in effect on June 10, 2026. You will be notified as far in advance as possible in the event the price of the tour needs to be adjusted. We do not foresee this happening, but in today's economic climate, we have to be prepared for any currency

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discontinuation, devaluation, or "reset" that can affect any of the countries that we visit, transit, or to which we provide governance. We will do everything possible to prevent this from happening, but we have to be mindful of the world's current political climate.

SAFETY

The safety of our passengers is a primary concern of LP but also of the owners and operators of the vessels, aircraft, camps, resorts, ground transportation, and other facilities being used. If safety is threatened by any factors, the owners/operators of other facilities and services reserve the right to make whatever changes to the itinerary or schedule that they deem necessary for the safety of all. In the event of danger or war, we will do everything possible to facilitate a change of dates, destinations, and vendor refunds. It all depends on timing and geography. There is never a set standard of operation. In 20 years, we have never seen an entirely negative outcome for a group. However, we do live in interesting times. In the event that you choose to climb, hike, snorkel, dive, or take part in any activity, you are solely responsible for ensuring that you have the capabilities to perform the activities. There will be additional Saudi emergency services that will be offered in the coming months. This is supplied by a separate company for those who engage in these types of activities. We are traveling to Jabal al-Lawz and the Split Rock of Horeb—both of which have neither tourism nor medical infrastructure.

MAJOR CHANGES

Destinations and the sites offered here can be withdrawn at any time due to government restrictions and other reasons beyond our control. Cancellations attributed to Covid or to any new disease-related creations and acts of war, postponements, and such of any kind are not the responsibility of LP. You are booking the trip at your own risk, and penalties will not be waived. If LP first knows of a major change less than 21 days before scheduled departure, LP's liability is limited to refunds that we can obtain on your behalf, excluding insurance and any other nonrefundable airfare paid or visa fees, and nonrecoverable costs from our vendors, but not for any COVID or other named health or vaccination mandate. LP contracts with certain hotels to supply accommodation. Occasionally, the accommodation reserved is not available for a variety of reasons (i.e., unexpected maintenance problems, guest stay-overs, and over-booking by the hotel), and a substitute hotel of equal or greater quality is provided. In the event that your hotel standard is being substantially downgraded, a refund reflecting the difference in price will be issued. A change in currency or exchange is not considered a major change. REQUIRED INSURANCE DOCUMENT
